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## Film Club Assistant (x 2)

- Expected time commitment:
  - 10 x half day (4 hour) sessions and a showcase event between 30 March 2021 and 19 June 2021.
  - 10 hours preparation and feedback time
- Pay
  - £9.50 per hour
  - Total 50 hours
  - PAYE
  - Paid monthly
- Location
  - The Old Electric, Springfield Road, Blackpool
  - The Magic Club
  - If coronavirus restrictions do not allow physical sessions, we will host the sessions online (via Zoom)

### Duties

- The Film Club Assistant will support the session delivery staff; this will be a staff member from Blackpool and the Fylde College (Film Studies) or a guest speaker from the film industry.
- Sessions will be based on the international Cinema Education Programme's *Places and Stories* curriculum. The sessions will focus on:
  - Film theory/ watching film
  - Filmmaking
  - Industry and careers
- The Film Club Assistant is expected to attend all of the activity days
- This is an ideal role for someone starting out in the arts or film, especially suited to those with a background or interest in cinema and filmmaking.

- Taking photos and film clips for reporting purposes

## Skills

- A good working understanding of :
  - Filming equipment: Participants will learn to use JVC eng cameras and dslrs, tripods, radio mics, zoom mics
  - Editing Equipment: Participants will learn to use Premiere Pro on iMacs provided by Blackpool and the Fylde College
- Ability to explain filmmaking/cinema concepts and techniques to young people simply and effectively.

## Reporting

- The Film Club Assistant will report to the Film Club Coordinator with regard to session activity.
- You will also be supported by delivery staff from Blackpool and the Fylde College and Aunty Social board members.
